Pictures are few and the teacher is allowed unusual latitude. In the Heath arithmetic everything has been tested beforehand and there is nothing whatever experimental in the book. It combines three things, viz. , logical system, exact directions to teachers, and conforms to the demands of business life (the first and last being in their very nature unharmonizable). Topical and spiral ideals are also harmonized. All, we are told, is simple, logical, practical, with much drill, yet much principle. The child must understand processes, and yet chief emphasis must be laid upon results. The first pictures are beautifully colored, and colored discs are used again to illustrate and sweeten the bitterness of fractions. The first work is chiefly mental arithmetic, and after that, in a separate compartment of the book, come mensuration and the four fundamental rules, with written work. The...
