

He said he could never be thankful enough to God for putting him in the hands of the kindest woman that ever lived, in his old age. His presence in the family was a blessing to us all. In September, 1848, he took his bed, to rise up no more. All through his sickness he was elated with the prospect of soon being at home. He seemed to be conversing with invisible...
